COMPETITION RULES

Latest WKF competition rules apply.

Athletes are fully responsible for their medical allowance to participate in the tournament as well as insurance.

The organizer reserves the rights to change the categories with too few entries in category. Each country can register two (2) competitors in each individual kumite and kata category.

Kata

Kata female: cadet, junior and senior

Kata male: cadet, junior and senior

Kata team female (age +14)

Kata team male (age +14)

Kumite

Kumite female cadet: -47kg, -54kg, -61 kg, +61 kg

Kumite female junior: -48kg, -53kg, -59kg, - 66 kg, +66 kg

Kumite female senior: -50kg, -55kg, -61kg, -68kg, +68kg

Kumite male cadet: -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, +70kg

Kumite male junior: -55kg, -61kg, -68kg, -76kg, +76kg

Kumite team female: Senior (age +18)

Kumite team male: Senior (age +18)

Mixed Cadet kumite teams – male (3+1) and female (2+1)

PARA KARATE CATEGORIES

K10 Blind/visually impaired

BLINDFOLDS ARE REQUIRED

- Athletes who have no sight in both eyes
Blindness: No light perception
- Athletes who have limited vision in both eyes:
Visual acuity ranges from 3/60 to light perception in the less-impaired eye
- Athletes who have limited vision in both eyes:
Visual acuity ranges from 6/18 to 3/60 in the less-impaired eye

K20 (includes K21and K22) Intellectually impaired

- K21: Athletes must have an IQ of 75 or lower on standard tests, having originated before the age of 18. Evidence of significant limitations in adaptive behaviour as expressed in conceptual, social, and practical adaptive skills.
- K22: Athletes who have an intellectual impairment and Down Syndrome as caused by extra genetic material in chromosome 21.

JUDGES AND REFEREES

Qualified Referees with an international or each country's highest national licenses are welcome to participate in the NKC. The age limit for attending the NKC as referee or attending course is 20 years. Please register via Sportdata.org by Sunday 30 March 2025.

Max 10 referees per country.
